Be prepared to get dirty!! Wearing appropriate shoes can make or break this trip for students.

• <u>Tall rubber boots and/or hiking boots</u>: athletic shoes are not advised.
There is high potential to become wet and muddy and some areas we work will be rocky and semi-difficult to navigate. We encourage an extra pair if your shoes become wet and don't dry in time!
