Living Lands & Waters Teams Up with ADM

Who: Chad Pregracke's non-profit river cleanup, Living Lands & Waters (LL&W) will be teaming up with Archer Daniels Midland (ADM).

What: LL&W is teaming up with the Illinois DNR and ADM employees to do a cleanup followed by a fish release of 3,000-5,000 muskellunge into Lake Shelbyville.

When: Thursday, August 25 - The cleanup will be from 10:00am-11:20am. The fish stocking will begin at 11:30am, with lunch served after.

Where: Sullivan, IL – Forest W. Woods Access Area at Lake Shelbyville (Also known as Bo Wood Campground II Route 32, Shelbyville, IL 62565)
